<p><b>Learning Network</b> <i>(How do we learn from other state teams?)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Team Meetings</b> – MOS team meetings, MFLC/CYC team meetings</li> <li>• <b>Share “best practices”</b> through email.</li> <li>• <b>JFSAP Discussion Boards</b> – great way to share information</li> <li>• <b>Cold Call other states</b> and ask what they are doing</li> </ul>	<p><b>Updating</b> <i>(How do we adjust the plan as the situation changes?)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Monitor the My STATE database</b> to keep resources and information current and up to date.</li> <li>• <b>Review plan with JFSAP team</b> on a quarterly basis</li> <li>• <b>ISFAC</b> – Constant open communication and information sharing</li> </ul>
